

# Report Bullying or Harassment

Has your student been harassed or pushed around by another student or students while at school?

If while on school property, your child has ever been subject to:

*Theft*

*Assault*

*Vandalism*

*Extortion* (someone getting money from them "or else")

*Physical violence*

*Verbal or written threats*

*Teasing that goes too far*

*Gossip or rumors*

*Fear for personal safety*

then he or she might be the victim of a bully.

## The law is on your side!

The law says that students have a right to come to school and learn in a safe and secure environment. If your student - or your student's friend - is being bothered by a bully, or being harassed while in school, there are things that can be done to stop it.

***The most important thing is to tell someone in authority about it.***

Let your student know that whether they go to a teacher, a counselor, the nurse, or straight to the Principal, it is important to let someone in charge know what's been happening. They care about their students, and they will know what to do to make sure the situation is resolved.
