

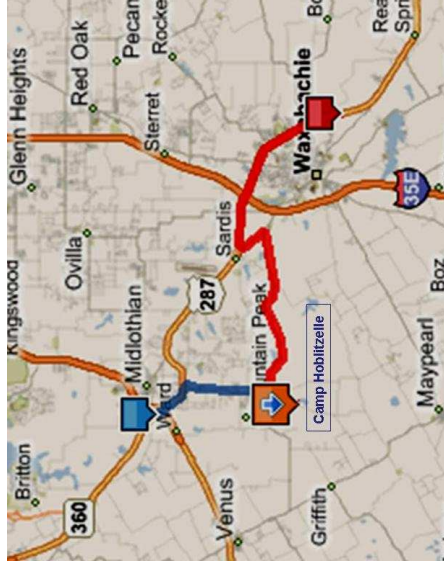


Evacuation Basics and Reunion Site

An evacuation is used when the school building is not safe for students or staff. During an on-site evacuation, students and staff are moved away from the building. During an off-site evacuation, students and staff will be transported to the Reunion Site.

- If an emergency occurs in MISD where one or more schools must be evacuated for a significant period of time, the designated Reunion Site for parents and students is Camp Hoblitzelle. (see map and directions below).
- Students and staff will be transported to the Reunion Site by bus and kept secure. The Camp has sufficient parking for parents and emergency responders, and provides safe and secure buildings in which to temporarily secure students.
 - Parents will be notified through MISD's emergency notification system that an evacuation has taken place and that they should report to Camp Hoblitzelle to be reunited with their children.
 - At the Reunion Site, in order to have the student(s) released to them, **parents/guardians will be required to present two forms of identification and to be listed on the student's emergency contact form as having permission to take the child.**

Camp Hoblitzelle is located at 8060 Singleton Rd., Midlothian 76065



Directions from North: Via 287S, exit FM663/14th St. Turn right onto FM663, after about 3.5 miles turn right on FM 875, then left on Singleton, travel approx. 1.2 miles to the camp.

Directions from South: Via 287N take 287 Business, turn right onto FM875, travel approx. 4 miles to Singleton, turn left, travel approx. 1.2 miles to the camp.
