



LOCKDOWN

A Lockdown is intended to limit access and hazards by controlling and managing staff and students in order to increase safety and reduce possible victimization.

Lockdown Information and Procedures

- During a lockdown, staff and students are secured within the building
- No one is allowed to enter or leave the facility until an "All Clear" signal is given by District officials
- A lockdown may be called for a variety of reasons including:
 - immediate threat of danger
 - police activity in or around campus
 - weapons offense
 - environmental hazard
 - weather emergency
- If you are visiting one of our campuses when a lockdown is ordered, we ask that you remain calm and follow the instructions of staff. You will be directed to a safe area until the event is concluded.
- If you are notified that a lockdown is in progress at your student's campus, please DO NOT call the school or drive to the campus to pick up your student. Allow school officials and emergency responders to work to keep the students and schools safe and secure.

REMINDER: During a lockdown, no one will be allowed to enter or leave the building.
