



SHELTER IN PLACE

A Shelter in Place is implemented when a situation occurs that may be a hazard to health or is life-threatening. It can be used when it is safer to keep students, faculty, staff and visitors inside the building rather than expose them to possible harm by allowing them to leave the building.

Shelter in Place Information and Procedures

- **During a Shelter in Place, staff and students are secured within the school facility. However, most entrances and exits remain open to allow others to seek shelter inside.**
- **A shelter in place may be called for a variety of reasons, including:**
 - **weather emergencies**
 - **chemical spills**
- **If you are visiting one of our campuses when a shelter in place is ordered, please stay calm and follow the directions of staff. You will be directed to a safe area until the event is concluded.**
